A farmstead surrounded by rig and furrow fields with an outlying, rectangular shieling-type building.

1. Farmstead at NM4587067973. House 10m x 5m with entrance in long wall facing NE, walls containing exceptionally large stone blocks. At SE end of building, a byre, width 1.5m. Building at NE side of a square 'kale yard' 16m x 16m, with a further walled area to NW.

2. Hut at NM4592367752. Rectangular hut resembling shieling hut 3m x 2m, with entrance at SW, short end, lying in rig and furrow fields – so not a shieling.

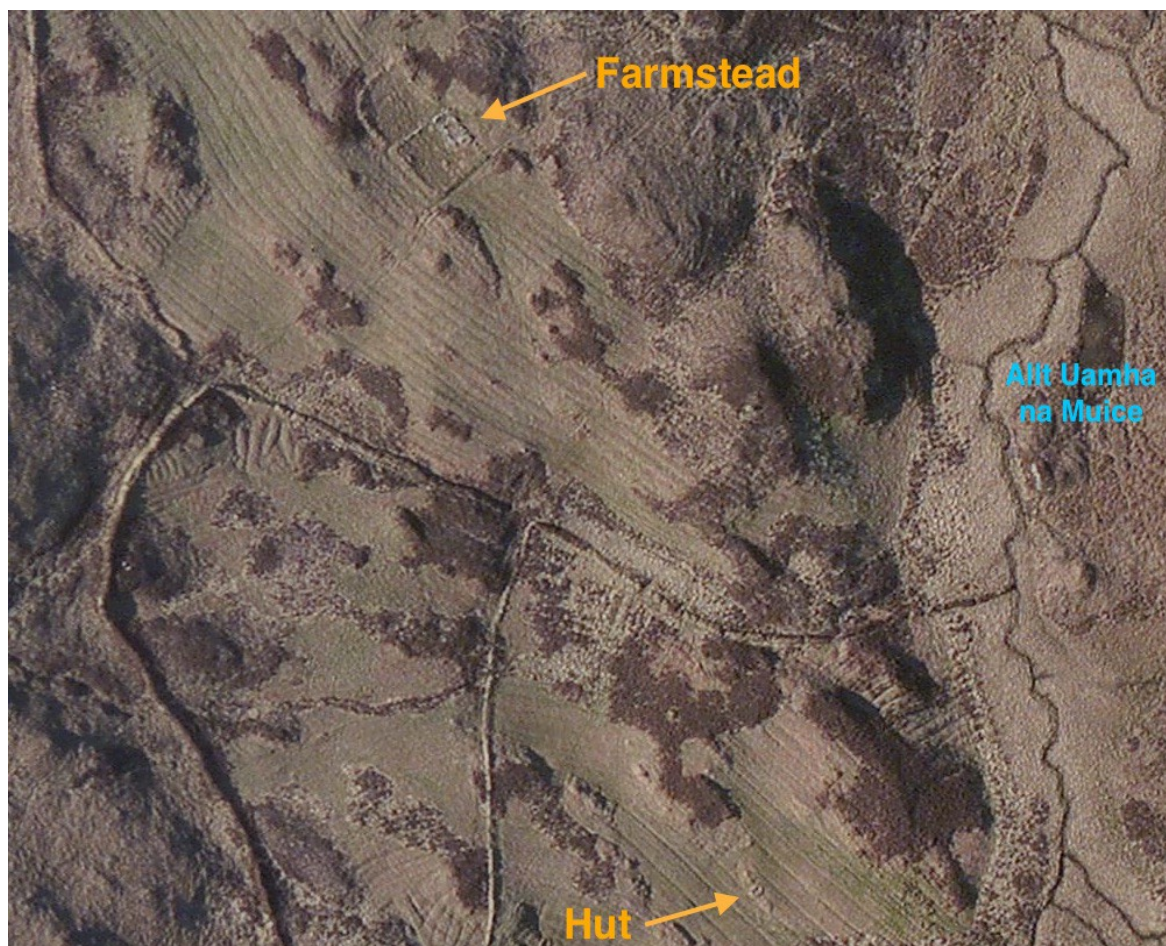
